

Disk Instructions

This book includes a high-density (1.4MB) Macintosh disk that contains an assortment of hand-picked, ready-to-run FileMaker Pro database templates, utilities, and demos. (See Appendix A for a detailed description of the contents.) To use the *Macworld FileMaker Pro 3 Bible* disk, you need the following:

- ⇒ A high-density floppy drive (also known as an Apple SuperDrive)
- ⇒ Almost 3MB of free hard disk space (if you want to extract all the files)

Extracting the Files

To extract files from the *Macworld FileMaker Pro 3 Bible* disk, do the following:

1. Insert the *Macworld FileMaker Pro 3 Bible* disk into the Macintosh's floppy drive. The disk window appears. The archives are stored in two folders. The Author Contributions folder contains all files that were discussed in the examples presented in this book. The Other Contributions folder contains freeware and shareware templates, demos, and utilities.
2. Open either folder and locate the archive you want. The disk contains eight separate archives. The contents of the various archives are described in Appendix A.
3. Double-click the archive's icon. The extraction program launches. The Select Destination Folder dialog box appears.
4. Use normal navigation procedures to select the disk and folder where you want to copy the contents of the archive.



Be sure to select a disk other than the *Macworld FileMaker Pro 3 Bible* disk — a hard disk, for example. Treat the *Macworld FileMaker Pro 3 Bible* disk as you would treat any master disk. If you ever need to reinstall any of the software, you can use the original disk to do so.

5. Click the Extract button. The Extracting dialog box appears. The files are extracted one-by-one from the archive and then are copied to the destination disk and folder that you selected in step 4.

When all files have been extracted, the extraction program automatically quits and you are returned to the desktop.

To extract the contents of additional archives, repeat steps 2 through 5.
