

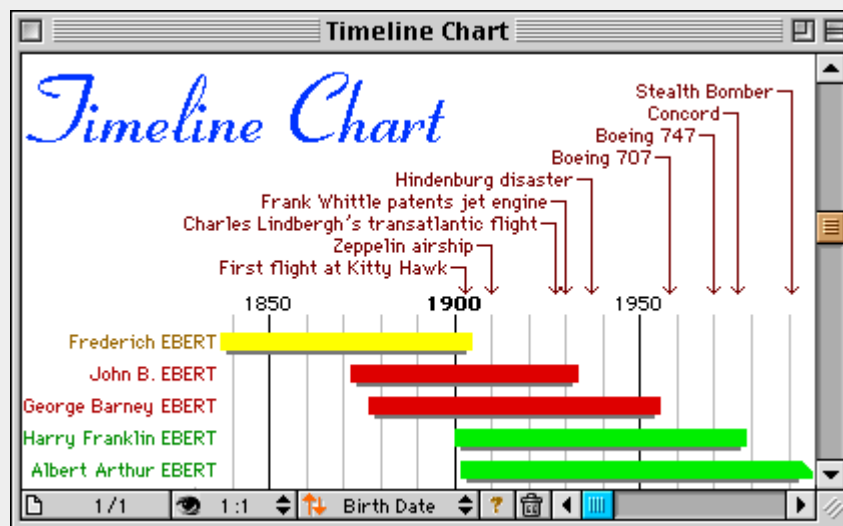

Perspective Event Sets

What is a perspective event?

In SuperChart, a **perspective event** is an event of historical significance which you can add to a timeline chart, thereby enhancing the legend of the chart. You can add perspective events one-at-a-time, or you can add an entire **set** of perspective events.

The timeline example below contains perspective events related to **aviation history**.

Share your perspective event sets

Your Reunion manual explains how to save a collection of perspective events as a "set." If you'd like to share your perspective events sets with other Reunion users, please send them to sets@LeisterPro.com. We'll post them on this web page.

Technical information about perspective event sets

A **perspective event set** is a text file with simple formatting.

Perspective event sets should be saved in the **Perspective Sets** folder, located inside the **Charts** folder in the **Reunion 6** folder.

You can use your text editor (SimpleText, TexEdit, etc.) to build your own sets by simply saving the relevant event list in a new text file.

The perspective event set file should contain only a list of years and events. Use tabs to separate the event description from the year. Use returns to separate each line. For example...

```
Year<tab>EventDescription<return>  
Year<tab>EventDescription<return>
```

Superchart will check the first four characters for the year value and place the perspective event in the timeline chart according to year. Lines with no years are ignored. If identical years are found, Superchart will display events with identical years in the order they appear in the set. Superchart will not accept decimal years, or dates that include month or date.

When you open a perspective event set into a timeline chart, SuperChart will only import the perspective events that fall within the bounds of the timeline (starting year to ending year).
