Installation Instructions

This brief font primer will help you to understand Macintosh fonts and install them properly. We suggest you read these two pages in their entirety. And please observe this important note: Only install the fonts you intend to use regularly!

Part One. TrueType or Postscript - Which is for you?

The fonts in the 1500 Font Mega Pack come in two flavors – TrueType and PostScript. You should decide in advance which type of font you wish to use. But how do you choose?

TrueType Fonts: TrueType fonts are ideal for 90% of Macintosh users. Unless you have specialized desktop publishing needs, we *strongly* suggest you use TrueType.

PostScript Fonts: If you've decided to use PostScript fonts, you should know that each one actually consists of a screen font (for on-screen display) and a printer font—represented by two separate files on the CD-ROM. Unless you use Adobe Type Manager software, you will also need a PostScript-compatible printer in order to print these fonts clearly at any size.

NOTE: An example from each font family is shown inside this booklet. Styles such as bold and italic are not shown. Multi-font families are grouped in suitcases for your convenience.

Part Two. System 6 Installation

TrueType Fonts	PostScript Fonts
You may copy the desired fonts into your System with the use of the Font/DA Mover utility. Please see your Macintosh Owner's Manual for details.	Copy the desired screen fonts into your System using the Font/DA Mover utility. Then return to the Finder and drag the corresponding printer font into your System Folder. (See Part Four for details.)

Part Three. System 7 Installation

TrueType Fonts	PostScript Fonts
Double-click your hard drive icon so that the the System Folder icon is visible. Then drag the desired fonts from the CD-ROM onto the System Folder icon. The Finder will place the fonts inside your Fonts folder.	Double-click your hard drive icon so that the the System Folder icon is visible. Then drag the desired fonts (both screen fonts and corresponding printer fonts) from the CD-ROM onto the System Folder icon. The Finder will place the fonts in the appropriate places inside your System Folder.)

Part Four. Installing PostScript Fonts

If you've elected to install PostScript fonts to your hard drive, you'll notice that the installation instructions make reference to both a screen font and a corresponding printer font. You'll need both to use a PostScript font. You'll find a corresponding printer font for each screen font inside the same folder on the CD-ROM. For example, the *BarbeDisSsIlta* printer font should be installed along with the *Barbe Display Ssi (italic)* screen font.

NOTE: While the PostScript fonts will print properly, they may appear jagged on screen unless you are using Adobe Type Manager.
