

Adobe Type Reunion® Deluxe 2.0

Quick Installation Card

The Adobe Type Reunion® Deluxe utility lets you control your application's font menu and organize fonts in an application based on font families instead of simply by font name. Use Adobe Type Reunion to:

- Group fonts into custom categories.
- Assign custom names to fonts (such as "Corporate" for Adobe Garamond®).
- Display fonts in their own typefaces.
- List your most recently used fonts at the top of your font menu.
- Use Type Reunion with Adobe Type Manager® Deluxe 4.0 to activate or deactivate font sets for better system performance.
- Specify which applications do not use Type Reunion.

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

Adobe Type Reunion 2.0 runs on any Macintosh®, Power Macintosh®, or compatible computer, and requires:

- Apple® system software 7.0.1 and higher. (System 7.1 or higher is recommended.)
- At least 8 megabytes (MB) of random-access memory
- A hard disk drive and high-density floppy drive

INSTALLING ADOBE TYPE REUNION

To install Adobe Type Reunion 2.0:

- 1 Hold down Shift as you restart your Macintosh computer.
- 2 Insert the Adobe Type Reunion 2.0 disk into your floppy disk drive.
- 3 Double-click the Install icon and follow the on-screen instructions.
- 4 Restart your Macintosh when the installation has finished.

USING THE FONT MENU WITH ADOBE TYPE REUNION

Using Adobe Type Reunion with an application enables your font menu to list alphabetically all fonts used in a document, show additional font styles and weights in submenus, and display font groups that you have created.

To display a font group in the Font menu:

- 1 In the Groups preference panel, select the Show Groups in Font Menus option. (See page 3 for more information.)
- 2 Using the mouse, select a group from the application's font menu, or choose Font > *Group Name* > Show Group Name (where *Group Name* is the name of the font group). A bullet precedes the name of the group.

USING THE ADOBE TYPE REUNION CONTROL PANEL

Adobe Type Reunion is a control panel installed in the System Folder that contains four preference panels.

To open the Adobe Type Reunion control panel, do one of the following:

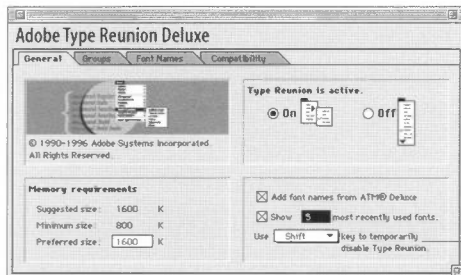
- Open the Control Panels folder in the System Folder, and double-click the Adobe Type Reunion icon.
- Choose Apple > Control Panels > Adobe Type Reunion.
- Choose Open Type Reunion from any font menu.

To display a Type Reunion preference panel:

Click the corresponding tab at the top of the Type Reunion control panel.

Using the Adobe Type Reunion General preference panel

Use the General preference panel to turn Adobe Type Reunion on or off, set the number of recent fonts Type Reunion should remember, and specify a temporary override key.



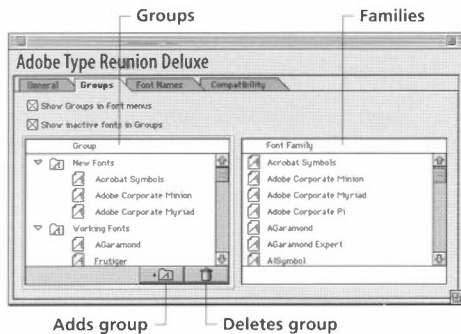
Choose a key to turn off

To use the Adobe Type Reunion General preference panel, choose from the following options:

- Click the On or Off master switch to turn Adobe Type Reunion on or off.
- To adjust the memory requirements if necessary, enter a new value in the Preferred Size text box.
- Select the Read Font Names from ATM® Deluxe option to display the font names in the ATM database. Deselect this option to suppress the font name display if you want to speed up Type Reunion and you don't plan to add any new fonts.
- Select the Show option to display the most recently used fonts at the top of your font menu.
- Choose a control key from the pop-up menu to use to turn off Adobe Type Reunion temporarily. When opening an application or selecting a font menu, hold down this key to view the application's original, unsorted font menu.

Using the Groups preference panel

Use the Groups preference panel to define custom font groups (such as serif fonts, body fonts, or display faces) that organize your fonts into groups for easy use. A font can belong to more than one group.



To use the Groups preference panel, choose from the following options:

- To create a font group, click the Add Group icon. In the left scroll box, select the group and type a name for it. In the right scroll box, select from the Font Family list (Shift-click to select multiple fonts) and drag the font to the group.
- To display a group in the main font menu, select the Show Groups in Font Menus option.
- To delete a font group, select it in the left scroll box, and click the Trash icon. Click OK.

To show or hide a group in the main font menu, choose from the following options:

Choose font menu > *Group Name* > Show *Group Name* or Hide *Group Name*. (*Group Name* is the font group's assigned name. Selecting Show Group shows only fonts in that group in the main font menu, and displays all other fonts in a font submenu.) A bullet precedes the active group name in the main font menu.

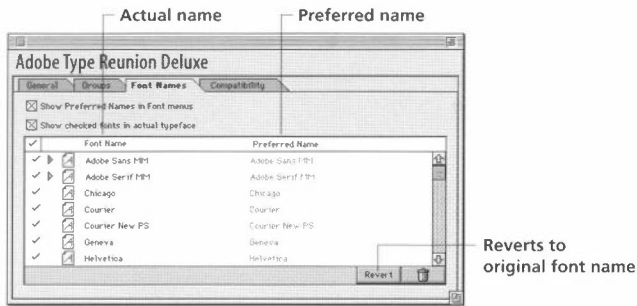
To redisplay all fonts, choose font menu > *Group Name* > Hide Group, or choose font menu > Show Active Fonts.

To use the Groups preference panel with ATM Deluxe 4.0 installed, choose from these additional options:

- To activate or deactivate an ATM set, choose font menu > ATM Sets > *Set Name* (where *Set Name* is the name of the set that you've created). A check mark precedes active sets.
- To list a font made inactive by ATM in the font menu, select the Show Inactive Fonts in Groups option in the Groups preference panel.
- To display the ATM Deluxe control panel, choose font menu > ATM Sets > Open ATM Deluxe.

Using the Font Names preference panel

The Font Names preference panel lists actual font names on the left and preferred font family names on the right. You can define new font names on the right side of the scroll box. Also use this panel to display fonts in their actual typeface. A check mark indicates that fonts will appear in their actual typeface.

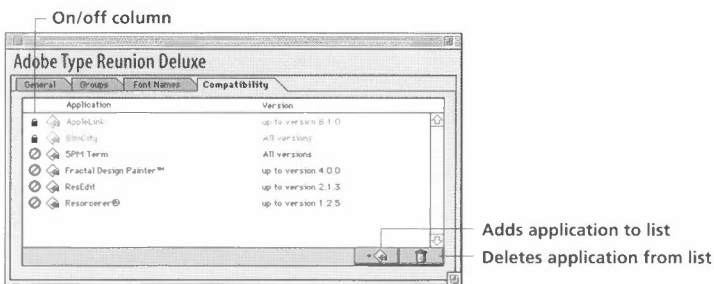


To use the Font Names preference panel, choose from the following options:

- To create a preferred name, select an actual font name on the left, click to its right in the Preferred Name column, type a name, and press Return.
- To change a preferred name back to the original font name, select the preferred name, and click Revert.
- To display preferred font names in font menus, select the Show Preferred Font Names in Font Menus option.
- To show selected fonts in their typefaces in font menus, select the Show Checked Fonts in Actual Typeface option.
- To not display a font in its own typeface (such as a symbol font) when a Show option is selected, click the check mark column to the font's left to hide the check mark.
- To delete a font from the Type Reunion Names file, select the font and click the Trash icon. Click OK.

Using the Compatibility preference panel

The Compatibility preference panel lets you turn off Adobe Type Reunion for a particular application.



To use the Compatibility preference panel, choose from the following options:

- To add an application to the list, click the Add Application icon, and locate and select the application to add.
- To turn Type Reunion on or off with the application, click the left column next to the application name to display a check (on) or a slashed circle (off).
- To remove an application from the list, select it and click the Trash icon. Click OK.
