Introduction

This "Fonts – Just in Time" CD-ROM version 5.0 outruns former versions of Linotype-Hell font CD-ROMs in two respects:

- The CD contains ever more fonts
- You can use the CD on both platforms Apple® Macintosh® and PCs with Microsoft® Windows.®

Use the electronic font catalog (the Browser) to view and select fonts to be ordered. The browser also contains the order form and fills the form with the information entered. Send the form to your font shop. The necessary access keys are then supplied to you. Enter the keys in the specific fields in the browser. You can immediately start using the fonts in the layout of your documents.

See the next chapter for a description of how to use the browser.

System Requirements

Your computer must meet the following requirements:

Macintosh CD-ROM drive

■ The Browser (Electronic Catalog)

The browser file contains three modules: font catalog, order module and unlocking module. The browser file exists in a Macintosh and in a Windows version.

■ Macintosh JIT Browser■ PC JITBRWSR.EXE

Open the file.

The browser is divided in eight windows:

Copying the Browser File

To start the "JIT Browser" file from your hard disk proceed as follows:

- 1. Copy the "JIT Browser" file into a folder on your hard disk.
- 2. Start the program.
- 3. Open the "Configuration" window and enter the drive used with your fonts CD-ROM.

In the "Language" window, click any of the buttons to select your language (English, Français, Deutsch).

Addresses of Distributor and User

If you entered the necessary information, the browser completes the order form automatically with the distributor's address and your own address.

Distributor's Data: Open the "Distributor" window to fill in the required data of your

typeface distributor: name, address, phone and fax.

User's Data Open the "User" window to fill in the required data: your name,

address, phone and FAX.

The data will be used with all future orders until you make some

changes.

Attention: Together with the unlocking keys for your first order a personal cus-

tomer ID may be assigned to you. Enter the customer ID into the

"User" window.

Configuration

In addition to the distributor's and user's profiles, the browser needs the following information. Select the "Configuration" window.

Enter Serial-number of CD: Read the serial number from the box of your CD-ROM and enter the

12 digit number into the corresponding field.

Select Volume for CD: Select from the list the correct font CD-ROM. If the volume is not

shown in the list, click "Update."

Attention: If for the first time you start to order an item for the first time of this

CD-ROM, be sure to click the "Update" button in this window.

Catalog

The "Catalog" dialog window allows you to choose "your" typefaces out of a quantity of more than 3.000 typefaces.

Content of Selected Folder: Use the mouse and click to make your choice on different levels: You

can choose between the different typeface libraries, the different typeface families etc. Down on to the single weight, you can select

your individual typeface library.

Click a directory and move up and down in the directory tree.

Open: To receive information regarding the contents of a selected folder

press the "Open" button or doubleclick on the foldername.

Close: Click the "Close" button to close the current directory.

Add: To order a single weight, a typeface family, or another product you only have to click the "Add" button at the bottom of the dialog win-

dow.

For more information for a single weight select the "Example" dialog window. For an overview on the fonts selected for your order,

select the "Order" dialog window.

Example

Example: For a WYSIWYG representation of a specific typeface, select the

weight and open the "Example" dialog window.

Add: If you want to order the typeface click this button.

Hold If you want to compare examples of different typefaces, click "Hold." You can than open a new example window for each typeface

you wish to inspect. If you decide to order an item, you need not to

close the other dialog windows beforehand.

You can select another typeface and click the "Catalog" dialog window. Or use the left and right arrow buttons to page through the cat-

alog.

Ordering Items

Order #: The "Order" dialog window lists your current selection of items to

be ordered.

Remove entry: You can delete individual items from your order. Select an entry in

the list and click the "Remove Entry" button.

Clear Order: Click the "Clear all" button to delete the complete order.

Print Order: For a printout of the finished order form, you simply click the "Print

Order" button.

However, before the form will be printed, the valid licenze conditions are shown on screen. The Conditions are part of your order. Set your signature to the printed form and send it to your typeface dealer. You will soon receive the unlocking keys for each product.

Unlocking Items

For each item ordered an unlocking key must be entered into the "Unlock" window. Start the browser.

Entering the Customer ID: If you want to enter your customer ID you may open the "User win -

dow. Enter the ID. Now click the "Unlock" window.

Product Unlocking History: The list box displays all fonts ordered and not yet unlocked. Click

one of the radio buttons to select any of the sorting criteria (Product $\,$

Name. Product Number and Order Number).

Select from the "Pending" popup menu if the list displays all items selected or only those that are "pending" to be actually ordered

Key for Product: To unlock ordered items, select all items that are marked with the

envelope symbol.

For each item, the product number is displayed. Enter the 16 digit

unlocking key for each product.

Click "OK." The items are subsequently installed to the specified

directory.

The Browser (Electronic Catalog)

A dialog window is displayed. Enter the name of the directory where you want the items to be installed.

Click "Cancel" to abort the unlocking procedure.

Other functions of this window are "Print History" and "Print Order from Selection."
