

# FLUENT LASER FONTS™ LIBRARY

## Addendum

We have made Fluent Laser Fonts even better since the publication of the User's Manual. This Addendum sheet is a must-read so that you will be aware of how the changes affect the installation of the fonts.

### Package Contents

The Fluent Laser Fonts Library package contains 7 floppy disks and an instruction manual. See the Disk Directory on this addendum for locating specific fonts on the floppy disks.

### LaserWriter Font Utility

LaserWriter Font Utility was written by Apple Computer, Inc. and can be used to install Fluent Laser Fonts on hard disks attached to PostScript printers. This utility should come with your PostScript printer. If you do not have this utility, we can supply you with a copy. ### Installation

Instead of just one Fluent Laser Fonts disk illustrated in the manual, you now have 7 disks in your Fluent Laser Fonts package. Also, all the fonts on a disk are now visible in the window you see when you first open the disk, so there are no fonts in folders. The following instructions replace their equivalents in the manual.

#### To Install Screen Fonts:

1. Start the Macintosh with the System Disk or Hard Disk that is to have screen fonts installed. Fonts will be installed on the Startup Disk. Its icon should appear at the top right corner of your screen.
2. Insert the Fluent Laser Fonts Disk #1, 2, 3, or 4 into an available disk drive.
3. Double-click on the Font/DA Mover icon. The Font/DA Mover will open and display a list of the fonts already installed in the System.
4. Click on the **Open** button under the blank window.
5. Open the screen fonts file on the Fluent Laser Fonts disk.
6. Select a desired screen font by clicking on the name. If only one font is selected, a sample will be displayed at the bottom of the window. You can select more than one size at a time by dragging the arrow downward through names or shift clicking on each name.
7. Click on the **Copy** button to install the screen fonts in the System File.
8. Click on the **Quit** button when all the needed fonts are installed.
9. Eject the current FLF Library disk by dragging its icon to the Trash.
10. Insert the next disk into the drive and repeat screen font instructions on that disk. Repeat this process for the first four disks in the library.

### Installing Printer Fonts

The printer font files are located on FLF Library disks 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7. They can be identified by their "LaserWriter" icons and their abbreviated names such as "CalliLas" for CalligraphyLaser.

The printer font files can be installed in several places. If you are unsure where you want to install the printer fonts, the System Folder is recommended. (see pg. 8 of the manual for further instructions)

### Using Fonts

All the Screen Fonts provided in the Library are NFNT types with IDs registered with Apple Computer, Inc. This means that you are less likely to have font ID conflicts when using many fonts.

#### Please Note:

Some of the fonts in this Library are linked as a family. For example, BodoniLaser, BodoniItalic, BodoniBold, and BodoniBoldItalic are linked together. When a family is linked in this manner, only the plain style (i.e. BodoniLaser) appears in the Font menu. You must select Italic and/or Bold in the Style menu to access the other members of the family.

When fonts are not linked in a family, all of their names will appear in the Font menu. For example, Jott, JottQuick, JottLight, and JottQuickLight are NOT linked and all four names will appear in the Font Menu. You should not use the Style menu to modify unlinked fonts. Selecting Bold in the Style menu will cause a double image of the font to be printed with one image slightly offset. Generally this creates an unacceptable result. If Italic is selected in the Style menu, the font will be slanted by the computer. This does not provide a true italic and tends to distort round characters like the "o".

Individual fonts like RegencyScript, Gazelle, Gregorian, and others that do not have bold or italic versions should not be modified using the Style menu.
