Bert, your parents have brought you here today to reveal a secret. Ethel do you have something to say to Bert?

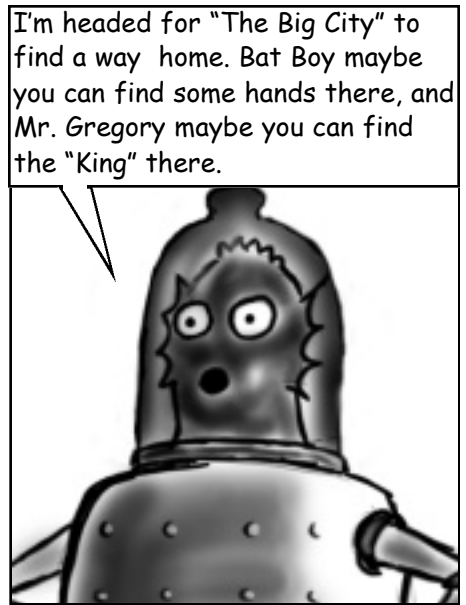
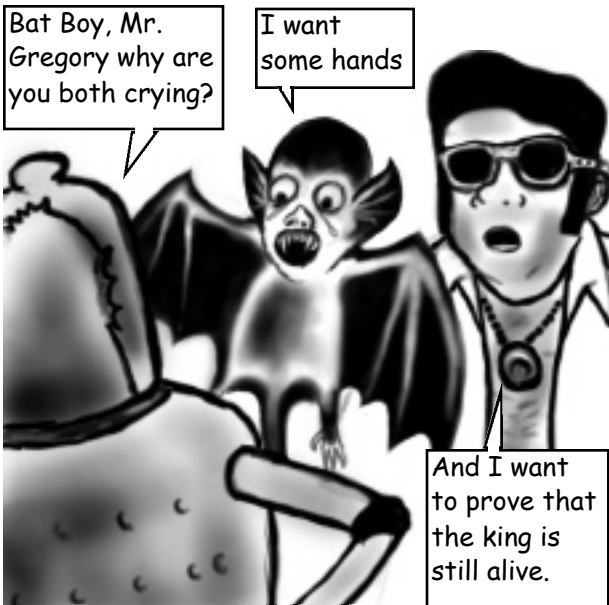
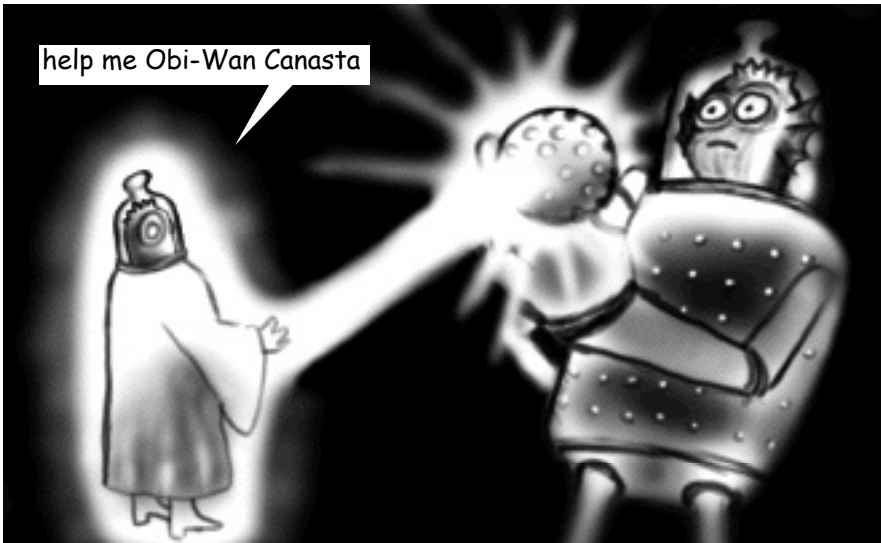


Oh my GOD!

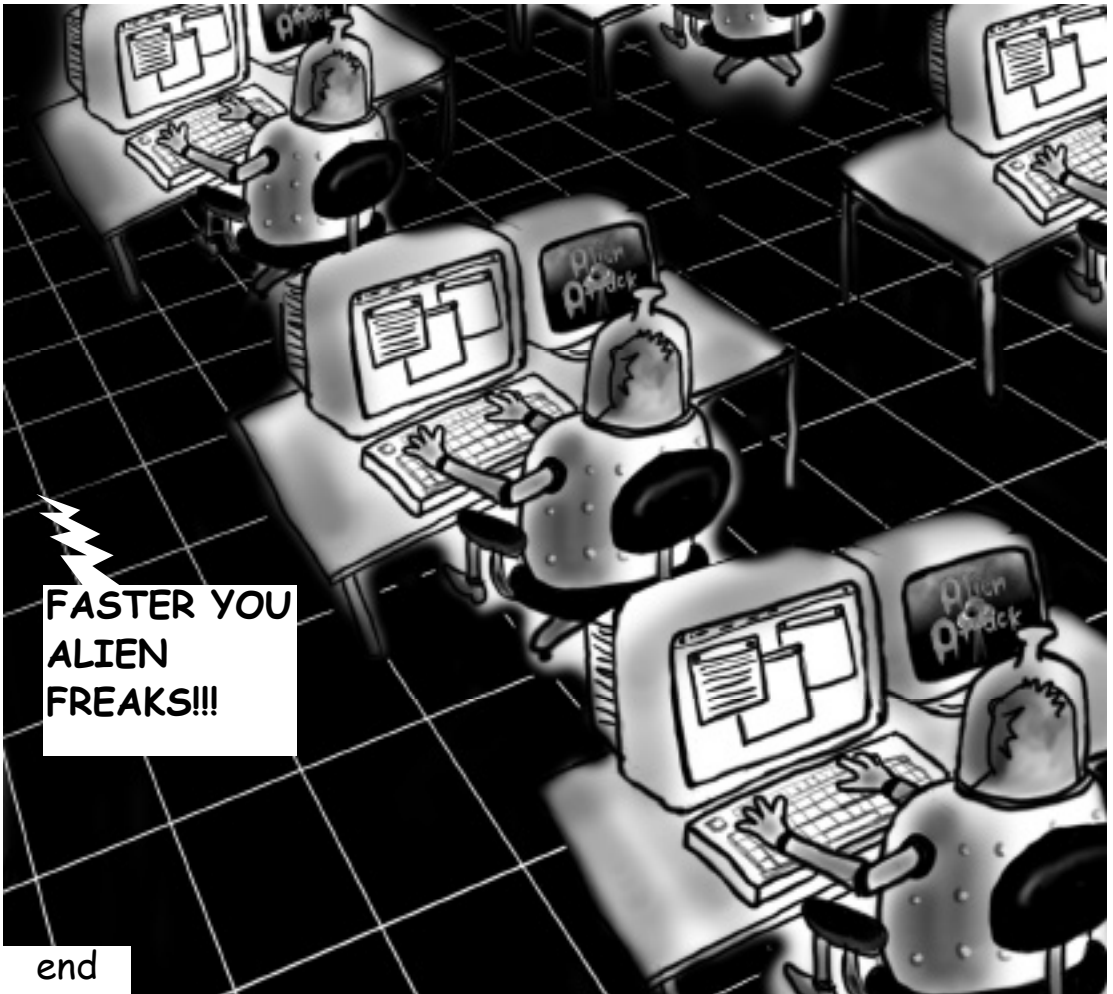
