



Empire Deluxe was originally developed for DOS. This version of Empire has been completely rewritten from the ground up to take maximum advantage of the Macintoshes unique features. The manual's installation, setup, and keyboard commands are for the DOS version, so you will find that those areas of the manual do not pertain to the Macintosh version. Follow the instructions below to install and setup your Empire game, and press Command-H at any point during the game to bring up the on-line help menu.

#### Installation Instructions and Reference Guide for Macintosh

#### Installation

Insert Empire Deluxe Disk #1 into your computer's floppy drive.

Double-click on the Empire Installer. Press tab or click on the Drive button to select the install disk. Press return or click the Install button to begin the install. The install program will let you know if you have enough hard disk space for Empire.

Before you install, you can choose whether you want to install support for Color or Black & White, the Sounds file for Empire, or the Empire Scenarios by clicking on

the appropriate check boxes.

- When the install program has finished, it will have created a Empire Deluxe folder on your hard drive. Double-click on the Empire Deluxe icon within this folder to start Empire.
- If there are any errors, the Install program will report them. If you have any problems installing Empire Deluxe, contact our Technical Support at (818) 889-5650 from 9am - 12 noon or from 2pm - 5pm Mon - Fri PST.

#### **Preferences**

- The Game Default Preferences screen lists the default settings that Empire Deluxe will use when you start the game.
  - Production Reports allows you to turn off the reports for production of units.
  - Sound/Music allows you to turn the sound effects, music and warnings on and off.
  - Delays allows you to set the time Empire takes for messages, battles and movement.

- Map Scrolling allows you to turn on and off whether the Empire Deluxe map will scroll about the screen slowly (Fast Scroll Off) or jump from point to point (Fast Scroll On).
- Automatic Demo will turn on Empire Deluxe's demonstration mode after about a minute of inactivity. You can click the mouse anywhere to go back to where you left off.

#### Remote Players

Empire Deluxe for the Macintosh can play against up to six Macintoshes or PCs over a modem or across an AppleTalk network. When you begin a new game, you are given the option to connect remote users. From this screen you can setup whether you are using any remote accessing tools such as a modem, null-modem cable or a local area network.

For both the Modem and Printer ports, you can select 3 parameters, as follows (You must have either a modem or a null-modem cable attached to either port):

Connected To can be one of 2 values:

Modem informs the game that this port is used to connect to a modem.

**Direct** is used when this port is used to connect directly to another remote system, via a NULL-modem cable.

**Baud** determines the default baud rate to be used for this port. This default can be changed by the game.

Connection can be automatic or manual. Automatic connections will prompt you for the phone number to dial and do all the work. Manual will start a mini terminal program that lets you control the connection process.

The AppleTalk option will automatically detect an AppleTalk connection. Note that Empire Deluxe for PC's does not support AppleTalk, but you can connect to PCs via a modem or null-modem cable.

Once you have correctly set your options, you may start the game by selecting **OK** or select **Cancel** if you do not wish to use these options.



Press Command-H at any point during the game to bring up the on-line help menu.


Once you have selected the number and type of players, you will be asked for a password to verify that you have a legal copy of the program. Passwords can be found in your *Empire Deluxe* manual on the page specified by the program.

In order to load a scenario or a map file (such as TUTORIAL.SCN), you must choose to begin a game in Standard or Advanced mode. A dialog box will be displayed that lets you choose to Load World Map or Load Game Scenario. The default maps and scenarios are stored inside your *Empire Deluxe* folder in a folder called Maps.




