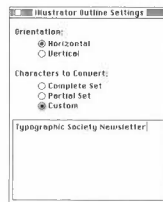
TYPE THREE TO TYPE ONE

EVOLUTION™ converts most type 3 PostScript® fonts to Adobe® type 1 format and vice versa. Type 1 fonts produced by EVOLUTION are completely compatible with Adobe Type Manager™ (ATM). Finally, sharp and easy-to-read display text for all of your fonts, not just Adobe fonts. Fonts may be processed singularly, or in batches defined by the user. The ability to convert to an ATM compatible font means that any font can be printed on any printer. Even users of non-PostScript® printers such as the Apple LaserWriter® II SC or Apple ImageWriter® can benefit from the ability to render PostScript® fonts. Additionally, when EVOLUTION type 1 fonts are printed on a PostScript® printer or imagesetting device, they can take advantage of certain properties of the raster image processor (RIP) within the printer. The result is cleaner, more clearly rendered characters at smaller point sizes and a significant increase in document processing speed.



EPS OUTLINES

EVOLUTION also converts type 3 or type 1 PostScript® font files to editable outlines for use in Adobe Illustrator® or Aldus FreeHand™. Optional settings allow the user to convert the entire character set, a minimal character set or a customized headline. The EPS outlines produced can also be specified with either horizontal or vertical orientation.



NO POSTSCRIPT PRINTER

EVOLUTION does not rely on a PostScript® printer to process a font, so it can run on any Macintosh or Macintosh network. Consequently, EVOLUTION runs more efficiently than similarly featured font conversion utilities which require the raster image processor within the PostScript® printer to do the processing.



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
