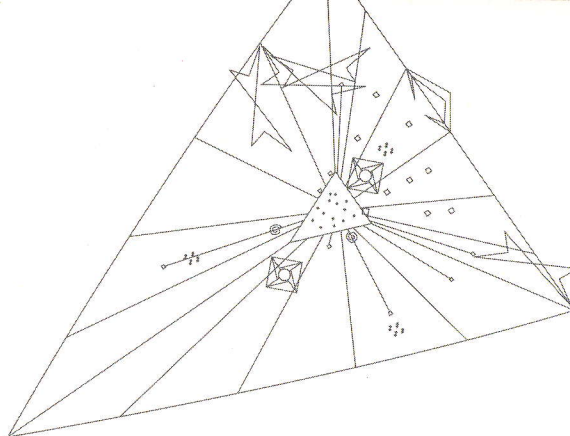


Microsoft® Arcade for the Macintosh®



To install Microsoft Arcade

- 1 Turn on your Macintosh computer.
- 2 Insert Disk 1 - Setup disk in the disk drive.
- 3 Double-click the Setup icon.
- 4 Follow the instructions on the Setup screens to install Arcade on your hard drive.
 - If Setup displays a message that you do not have enough disk space, quit Setup and free up space on your hard drive by deleting unwanted files. Then run Setup again.
 - If Sound Manager™ version 3.0 is not already installed on your computer, Setup installs it for you, and then asks you to restart your computer so that you can hear better sounds.

When you complete Setup, a Microsoft Arcade folder is installed on your hard drive. You can now open the Microsoft Arcade folder, double-click any of the Arcade game icons, and start to play. Have fun!

To start Microsoft Arcade

- 1 Turn on your Macintosh computer.
- 2 On your hard drive, open the Microsoft Arcade folder.
- 3 Double-click the icon of the Arcade game you want to play.



- 4 From the File menu, choose New Game or press ⌘N.

To learn how to play a game

- Within each game, choose Help from the Options menu or press the ⌘H key for online help (strategies, scoring information, and more).
