

#### SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

You may use this product with any Macintosh running System 6 or System 7. The game works with both color and B/W monitors.

MACINTOSH CLASSIC, SE OR PLUS users: Drag the MacsBug INIT into your System Folder before using the game. Also, please review the special instructions on page 7.

#### BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Be sure to install the game by following the installation instructions on the next pages. Then, put the original disk in a safe place in case you experience problems with your hard disk.

NOTE: You are allowed to make a single copy of any software program for archival purposes only.

#### INSTALLATION

These instructions assume that you have already turned on your Macintosh and that the contents of your hard disk are displayed on your screen. If the contents of the hard disk are not displayed on your screen, double-click on the icon of your hard disk.

Step One: Create a Mission Starlight folder on your Hard Disk.
a. Select New Folder from the File menu.



b. Enter the name Mission Starlight on your keyboard.

Step Two: Insert Disk One into your disk drive.

This will display the contents of the floppy disk.



NOTE: If you don't see this screen, double-click on the Mission Starlight disk icon. Step Three: Copy the contents of Disk One to the Mission Starlight folder you created in Step One.

(Before completing this step, be sure that both the contents of Disk One and the Mission Starlight folder you created in Step One are visible. If they're both not visible, either drag the Mission Starlight folder or the Disk One contents window to another place on the screen.)

- Click and hold down the mouse-button on any of files on Disk One.
- While holding down the mouse-button, drag the pointer until it is directly over the icon of the Mission Starlight folder you created in Step One.
- c. Release the mouse-button once the Mission Starlight folder turns dark. It should turn dark when the pointer is directly above it with a file ready to copy.
- Repeat these actions for the remaining files on Disk One.

Step Four: Copy the contents of Disk Two to the Mission Starlight folder you created in Step One.

Repeat the actions you followed in Step Three.

To play the game, double-click on the Mission Starlight program icon located in the Mission Starlight folder on your hard disk.

The playing instructions are in the game.

#### SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

If you are using a

MACINTOSH PLUS MACINTOSH CLASSIC MACINTOSH SE:

- · Drag the MacsBug INIT into your System Folder
- If you have only 1MB of memory, you will need to remove all the Inits from your System Folder before playing the game.
   Place these Inits in a temporary folder outside the System Folder and be sure to restart your machine before playing the game.

If you are using SYSTEM 6 and experience problems or slow playing speed:

- Check for other applications running under MultiFinder, or for the presence of a menu bar clock such as SuperClock.
- If necessary, play the game under Finder, rather than under MultiFinder. You can change this by adjusting the startup options under the Special menu and then restarting your Macintosh.

Note: You cannot record high scores while playing the game under MultiFinder.
