Solitaire Royale for the Macintosh® II

You have purchased the color version of *Solitaire Royale* written specifically for the Macintosh II. Please use the instructions in the manual for loading the program, except as noted below.

You should immediately make a backup copy of the diskette and use the backup for everyday operation. Follow the normal Macintosh conventions for copying disks, *but make sure your original disk is locked* (that is, the write-protect tab is set).

To run *Solitaire Royale* from your hard drive, copy all files except the **System** and **Finder** from the original disk to the hard drive.



Solitaire Royale automatically uses the color mode in effect when it is loaded (e.g., black-and-white, 16 or 256 colors). You can use other color modes if you choose by selecting them with the Control Panel desk accessory. (See your Macintosh II documentation for more information.) Note that if you change the number of colors after *Solitaire Royale* has already started, the program will redraw the cards in the wrong colors.

The Macintosh II can have more than one monitor attached, each using a different number of colors at the same time. For example, you might have one screen with 16 colors, and a second with 256 colors. If you drag the *Solitaire Royale* window to a screen that is using more colors, the game will pause ten to fifteen seconds to redraw the cards with the greater number of colors.

♣ If you also own the regular (black-and-white *only*) Macintosh version of *Solitaire Royale*, your color version can open games saved with the black-and-white one. *However, games saved within the color version cannot be opened by the black-and-white only version.* (See page 37 of the User Manual for more information about saving games.)

♣ **Set Board Color.** This item (in the *Settings* Menu) allows you to choose the background color of the game board. You will see a dialog box with several controls. Click on the color in the wheel to choose one that pleases you. Use the scroll bar at the right of the wheel to change the brightness level. You can also make fine-tuning adjustments on individual color components with the controls on the left-hand side of the dialog box.

♣ With the exception of the *Tour*, the game is played exactly as outlined in the manual. (See pages 26 and 38 for specific instructions regarding the *Tour*.) Additionally, you may now select any solitaire game to start the *Tour*, not just Pyramid.
