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Loading Instructions

1. Turn on your Macintosh^R
2. Insert the Utopia disk
3. The program will "boot up" and you will see the Utopia title screen.
4. Just wait a few seconds and the game will automatically boot.

Object of the Game

All life in your galaxy is slowly coming to an end. The only hope for mankind is to locate and colonize the plentiful haven of UTOPIA. As an experienced space explorer your government has assigned you the task of finding the legendary haven.

You begin the most important mission of your life and set your ship's course for UTOPIA. The ship's alarm sounds. You are forced to crash land on a strange planet with UTOPIA just across a magical lake in the distance.

While attempting to discover the secret of crossing the lake, you encounter many treacherous obstacles and mystical creatures. As you journey through the petrified forest, underground rivers, swamps and caves you must gather over 80 objects to aid you in your quest.

Screen Layout

The screen's divided into three separate windows and a menu bar on top. The largest window on the left half of the screen is the one used for entering commands. All user interaction with Utopia will appear here.

The window on the top right is used for pictures, while the one below it is the location description window that shows where you are, the things you see and available exits.

Menu Descriptions

The menu bar appearing on the top of the screen has the following options as detailed below:

1. Apple—This box contains the program credits about Utopia.
2. File—Load Game—Allows the player to restart a previously saved game.
Save Game—Saves the current state of the game for replay at a later time.
Quit—Allows the player to terminate the game. Selecting this option will result in a dialog box appearing in the lower right of the screen, allowing the player to confirm or cancel. To restart the game after quitting, simply open up the Unicorn icon named Utopia.
3. Edit—Contains the standard undo, cut, copy, paste and clear entries. This menu is active only for the Desk Accessories and cannot be accessed from Utopia.
4. Shortcuts—Contains many of the more popular commands used in the adventure, so that you may use your mouse instead of typing, if you wish.

The above menu selections have keyboard equivalents, so the adventure can be played with or without the mouse.

How to Play

You can explore Utopia by typing in commands that will appear on the bottom line of the left-hand window. To enter a command, type a verb followed by an optional noun and press the Return key. For example, TAKE INVENTORY, LOOK, GO NORTH, INVENTORY, etc. The computer will interpret your command and respond accordingly. For quick play you can abbreviate your commands by typing in the first four letters of longer words.

The player can repeat the last command by hitting the ENTER key on the keyboard. The player's input from the last command will be displayed and executed.

The complete Utopia vocabulary is listed in the enclosed hint booklet. Using any verb or verb/noun combinations that are not included in the vocabulary will result in an appropriate message.

Playing Tips

The picture window is there to stimulate your imagination. Be sure to always check the window below the picture for a complete detailed description of your location and surrounding objects.

Always watch the command window on the left for informative messages that may appear during your adventure.

If you have made significant headway, and face a potentially dangerous situation, it is a good idea to save the game before going any further. It is recommended that games be saved on a separate disk, as detailed in the SAVE GAME OPTION following.

It is recommended that you make a map as you travel through Utopia. If you are really stumped, as a last resort, you can refer to the enclosed hint booklet.

Saving the Game

Pull down the File Menu and select the Save game option or use the corresponding keyboard command. A dialog box will appear. Type in the name you wish to give to the saved game and click save and your game will be saved on the Utopia game disk. Note, that due to disk limitations on the Utopia game disk, it is recommended that you eject the Utopia disk and save the game on another disk. When using another disk, simply follow the on-screen instructions.

Loading in a Previously Saved Game

Pull down the File Menu and select the Load option with your mouse or use the corresponding keyboard command. Select the game you wish to load and click open if your games have been saved on the Utopia disk. Otherwise, eject the Utopia disk and insert your separate saved game disk, select the desired file name and click open. The saved game disk will automatically be ejected and you will be prompted to reinsert the Utopia game disk.

The player can also launch a saved game directly from the Finder. This means that a saved game may be run by selecting the saved game icon and opening it, or simply by double clicking on the save game icon. UTOPIA will be loaded and the saved game will be started.

There are 2 groups of hints. Group 1 gives minimal hints while group 2 further details the corresponding hint in group 1.

All group 1 hints are expressed as anagrams. This means the letters in each word are rearranged. To decode

the hint, solve the anagram.

In group 2 hints, the words are written backwards. Group 2 hints should be used only as a last resort because they are quite detailed and will enable you to journey through Utopia with relative ease.

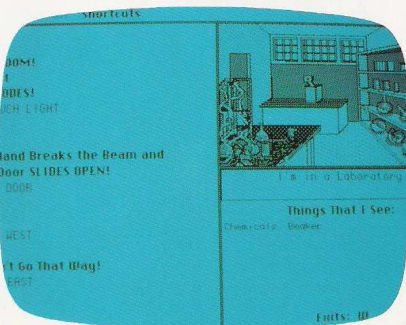
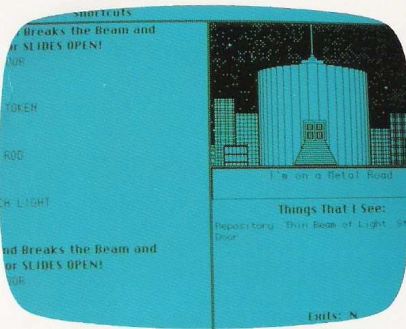

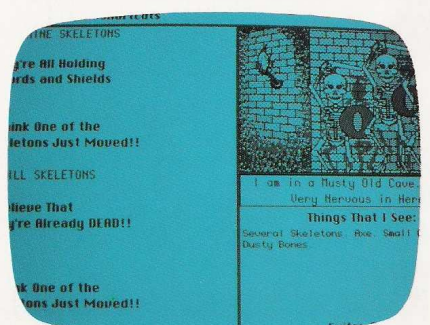
