
As you play Bane of the Cosmic Forge, you will see three icons on your screen. Wizardry will ask you to enter a magicword to continue.



Bane of the Cosmic Forge System's Reference Card Macintosh - All Models Mac Plus & Up

System Requirements

Your computer must be a Mac Plus or better and be equipped with at least 1 megabyte of memory and an 8-bit graphics card. Wizardry will not run if your computer has a 24-bit graphics card; switch to the default 8-bit graphics card instead.

To run in black and white, Bane of the Cosmic Forge requires approximately 800K of free memory. You may need to turn off background programs or any RAM cache to free up this memory. If you're running Wizardry in color, you will need approximately 1800K of free memory and 640 x 480 resolution.

Installing Bane of the Cosmic Forge

Inside your package, you'll find Wizardry Master diskettes labeled A-F. Before you install the disks on your computer's hard drive or begin playing from floppies, please make a copy of each diskette for backup purposes. In the list below, find your preference for play and follow the directions to install Bane of the Cosmic Forge on your computer.

Black and White - Floppy: You will need disks A-E for this combination. You will never need disk F, however; it is for color Macintoshes only.

 Make a copy of disk A. Do not write protect this disk. As you play Wizardry, the program will write information to this disk tracking your progress.

2. Just insert disk A into the drive and double click on the Bane icon. You may also boot the disk itself. In a moment, you'll be on your way into Bane

of the Cosmic Forge.

3. Format at least one blank diskette to save your games to. Wizardry will not format a diskette for you.

Black and White/Color - Hard Drive: Wizardry requires approximately 2.5 megabytes of *free* space on your hard drive; please be certain this space is available. To install Wizardry to your computer's hard drive, you'll need disks A-E for black and white or disks A-F for color.

Note: If you want to play in color you must install Wizardry on your hard drive. Only the black and white can be played from the floppies.

- 1. Double click on the hard drive icon.
- 2. Create a new folder. Name this folder BANE.
- 3. Double click on the new BANE folder so that it opens up the folder window (it will be empty).

4. Insert Master disk A into the floppy drive. Double click on the A disk to open the A disk window. After the disk is opened, press COMMAND and A to select all.

5. Press the mouse button down holding it over any icon in the Master diskette A window. Drag it over to the new Bane folder and let go of the mouse button. It will copy all the files on the Master disk to your hard drive.

6. When all the files have been copied, put the A disk icon in the trash. Your

computer will eject the disk.

7. Follow directions #4-6 for each disk you need to install. Be certain to do the disks in their correct alphabetical order. For black and white computers, you install disks A-E. For color, install disks A-F.

Note: Your computer will ask you if it should overwrite files of the same name. It is OK to do so.

8. Locate the System and General files in the BANE window. Put the System and General files in the trash can.

9. Once you have copied the contents of the Wizardry Master disks into the BANE window, locate the WINSTALL icon and double click on it. It will only take a few seconds to run and will configure the program to run from your hard drive. When it's finished, you will return to the desktop. You must run this program before playing from a hard drive. If you're playing off floppies, DO NOT run this program.

10. If you plan to play Bane in color, go to the Control Panel and select "Monitors". Set the number of colors to 16. You must do this before playing in color. If you are playing in black & white, set the colors to

Black & White.

11. Find the BANE icon in the BANE folder, and double click on it. In a few seconds, you'll be on your way into Bane of the Cosmic Forge.

Note: If Wizardry terminates abnormally and you are playing from a hard drive, there is a possibility that you did not run the WINSTALL program. Run it now.

IMPORTANT

Prepare Your Save Game Diskette Ahead of Time

Format at least one blank diskette for use as a save game diskette. All save game disks must be formatted ahead of time. Wizardry will not format them for you.

Wizardry's Interface

When you begin to play Bane of the Cosmic Forge, you'll notice one thing right away. The interface. It's not the same old run-of-the-mill interface you're used to. Why? Simply, it consumed more memory than we were willing to part with and slowed the game down immeasurably.

With over 100 calculations behind every swing of a sword, every flight of a spell, speed is of the essence. And that's what we wanted to bring you, not a combat round that lasted long enough to allow you a four-course dinner and a movie.

So, while you're getting used to the interface, we apologize for any inconvenience it may cause you. However, we feel that in the end, the increase in Bane's performance and the game play itself will more than make up for it.

Mouse or Keyboard

Wizardry automatically selects your computer's mouse as the primary input device. If you'd rather use your keyboard with highlighted menus, select "Keyboard" under the "Game Configuration" option.

About Multifinder

We recommend you don't use Multifinder, but run under the Finder instead. You can change your setup using the Set Startup command from the desktop menu bar. Once you've made this change, restart your computer.

Save Game Drive

Once you've created a band of adventurers, and have spent a bit of time within Bane of the Cosmic Forge, you will want to save your progress. In the "Party Options" window, select "Disk" followed by "Game Configuration".

Hard Drive: Leave the "Save Game" field blank.

Floppy: If you wish to save to a floppy drive enter 1: for the internal drive or 2: for a second, external drive. A colon (:) must follow the number of the drive. Save game disks must be <u>formatted</u> ahead of time.

Replacing "Replace"

In the manual, you will find reference to an option called "Replace". Using this command, you could replace one of your more experienced party members with a newly created, level 1 character. This option has been removed from the game. In effect, "Replace" defeated the essence of Bane of the Cosmic Forge... creatively directing a single party throughout the entire adventure. Therefore, this option is no longer available so you can enjoy the true essence of Bane of the Cosmic Forge without compromise.

WARNING

Please save your game often. Keep a backup save game around.

If you're playing on your hard drive, save your game to floppy every now and again. If you're playing from floppies, save your games to alternating formatted diskettes. Why? You never know when modern technology will meet a magnet thus eliminating all your hard work.

Black & White

If you're playing Wizardry in black & white, any reference to color in the manual won't do you much good. Below is a list of things which have been "colorized" in the manual and their black and white alternatives:

Picking Locked Doors: White: Tumbler is open Gray: Tumbler is closed

If all the tumblers are white when you click on the

mouse, the door will open.

Forcing Locked Doors: White: Your strength Gray: Door's strength

If your strength exceeds the door's strength when you

click on the mouse, the door will open.

Carrying Capacity: 00-65% Not encumbered

66-74% Slightly encumbered 75-89% Moderately encumbered 90-100% Heavily encumbered

Regardless of the amount of items your character carries, his or her carrying capacity will always appear white. However, the above percentages will allow you to determine the character's encumbrance. Refer to the

manual for the affects of encumbrance.

Troubleshooting - Hard Drive

You're playing from the hard drive. When you click on Bane's icon, the screen goes blank, but the game never begins.

1. If you haven't already, run the WINSTALL program.

2. Your computer may not have enough free memory available. You need approximately 1800K for color and 800K for black and white. You may have background memory resident programs consuming your memory. If this is the case, remove them from memory.

3. Check your graphics resolution and monitors setting. If you're running in

color, Wizardry needs a 640x480 resolution and a 16-color setting.
