To install Acrobat Reader 2.1 for Macintosh or Windows, follow these steps:

Macintosh users

Double-click the DAA disk icon. The DAA disk window opens. Double-click to open the READERS folder.
Double-click to open the MACINTOSH folder. Within the MACINTOSH folder, double-click the ACROREAD. MAC icon.

Windows users

From the Windows Program Manager, choose Run from the File menu. Type (YOUR CD-ROM DRIVE LETTER): readers\windows\acroread.exec and press Enter.

* Acrobat Reader 2.1 lets you view, navigate and print the lesson files. You will need Acrobat Pro 2.0 or later software to complete all the lessons on this CD. Acrobat 2.0 or Acrobat Exchange 2.1 will allow you to complete all but one lesson on this CD.
