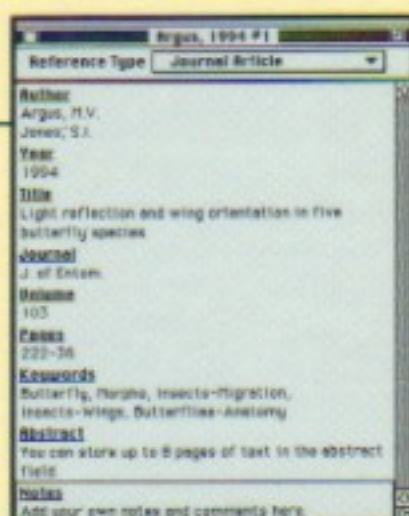

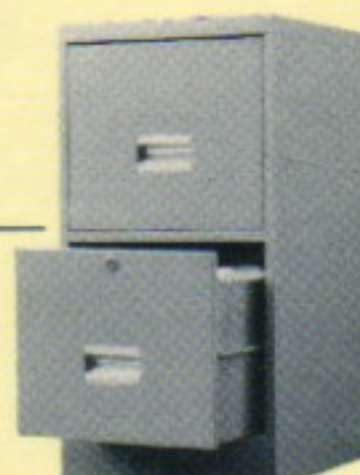

The discovery of *Morpho meleanus* in this area is interesting from the ecological point of view. In fact, it demonstrates a deep penetration of the species into an area previously considered ecologically hostile (32). It will be interesting to discover the reasons underlying this apparent adaptation.
